On Tuesday May 11, **Vinay Mudholkar, MBA** will be returning to campus to discuss with us his extensive experience with building and operating infrastructure, especially rail services, across the globe. His talk will interest a diverse group from various disciplines including engineering, management, strategy, international business, control systems, and others. He has worked on projects in New York, Boston, San Francisco, London, Chile, Korea, Mexico, and India. Most recently Mudholkar has been working in Saudi Arabia on the world's largest rail undertaking: 1490 miles of new rail enabling speeds up to 125 mph. Estimated to be worth USD \$6 billion, the train will connect Riyadh with the Northern parts of the country all the way up the Jordanian border.

Mudholkar holds an MBA from Northeastern and an MS in Civil Engineering from Worcester Polytechnic Institute. He has earned multiple awards and honors including from the American Society of Civil Engineers.
